GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of direction to the official respondents to take appropriate action against the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that she was married to respondent No.5 on 23.1.2019 but respondent No.5 as well as other members of his family have continuously been harassing the petitioner so as to press upon their demands of dowry. It has further been submitted that the aforesaid persons are not even returning the articles of *istridhan*.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without making any expression as regard merits of the case, the petition is disposed

of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur (respondent No.3), to look into the matter and to dispose of representation dated 29.7.2019 (Annexure P-2). In case the allegations leveled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-2 be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur (respondent No.3), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
