Prayer in CM-6809-C of 2019 is for withdrawal of the above mentioned appeal, which stands admitted, as the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties.

It is submitted that the terms and conditions of the settlement were reduced into writing on 07.01.2019, a copy of which, is attached as Annexure A-1 with the application. It is submitted that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties out of the free will of both the parties, without any kind of coercion or undue influence. The said application is accompanied by an affidavit of appellant-Harpreet Kaur.

Learned counsel for the non-applicant-respondent affirms and verifies the factum of compromise between the parties.

In view of the said compromise, the applicant-appellant seeks to withdraw the present appeal.

In view of the facts and circumstances as above, CM-6809-C of 2019, is allowed and the appeal is dismissed as withdrawn in terms of the settlement arrived at between the parties, which needless to say, shall form part of the decree.
