On 08.08.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner-accused and first informant are husband and wife. It is pleaded case of the petitioner that since they do not get along well, therefore, she has been falsely implicated at the behest of her husband.

Notice of motion for 30.09.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

On 30.09.2019, after noticing that petitioner has not joined investigation, last opportunity was granted.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder K. Bhatti, has submitted that the petitioner has not come forward to join the investigation.

Case has been called twice. Counsel for the petitioner is not present. Petitioner through this petition prays for grant of anticipatory bail. She has been twice given opportunity to join investigation while staying her arrest, however, she has not come forward to join the investigation.

Hence, the present petition is dismissed.
