Impugned herein is transfer order dated 30.07.2019 (Annexure P-3), whereby, the petitioner is being transferred from Dasuya to Jalandhar-I, which is stated to be in violation of transfer policy dated 23.04.2018 (Annexure P-2).

2. I have heard the petitioner who appears in person and contents of the writ petition have been perused.

3. Transfer being matter of administrative exigencies, this Court generally interferes, if at all, very cautiously. Transfer is not a punishment but an essential aspect of service, particularly, on a transferable post.

4. In my opinion, in the present case, the impugned transfer order dated 30.07.2019 (Annexure P-3) does not call for any interference from this Court in exercise of its extraordinary writ jurisdiction vested under Article 226 of Constitution of India.

5. Petition is, accordingly, dismissed being devoid of any merit.
