On 13.08.2019, the following order was passed:

“ Prayer in the petition is to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.55 dated 20.06.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur.

Reliance is placed on the order dated 01.08.2019 passed by this Court in CRM-M-32506-2019 arising from the same FIR.

Notice of motion for 24.09.2019.

To be heard alongwith CRM-M-32506-2019 on 24.09.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

On 24.09.2019, at the request of learned counsel for the State,
petitioner was again directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from H.C. Saroop Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, co-operated and not required for further custodial interrogation at this stage.

Hence, the order dated 13.08.2019 is made absolute.
