AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Having considered the submissions made by counsel for the parties and keeping in view the orders dated 14.09.2018 and 11.12.2019 passed by this Court, the present writ petition is disposed of by observing that on the next date of hearing fixed before the Financial Commissioner in

R.O.R. No.418 of 2018 (Balihar Singh Vs. Dayal Singh and others), which is now stated to be listed on 29.01.2020, contesting respondent Nos.2 to 4 herein shall put in appearance on the said date. The Financial Commissioner is requested to make an endeavour to decide the revision petition at an early date preferably within a period of four months from the date of appearance of the petitioners and respondent Nos.2 to 4 herein.

This order is being passed in the light of the fact that counsel for the petitioners and counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 4 are *ad-idem* that the contesting respondents are only respondent Nos.2 to 4. It is made clear that in case the petitioners do not cooperate during the hearing of the revision petition or unnecessarily seek adjournments, the Financial Commissioner would be at liberty to vacate the stay order granted by this Court.

Interim order dated 14.09.2018 passed by this Court in this case shall continue during the pendency of the revision subject to the above.
