“By this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR no.0045, dated 10.02.2015 registered at Police Station Sector-5, Gurugram, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 279 and 304-A of the IPC, stated to have been reached between the petitioner and respondent no.2, i.e. complainant in the FIR.

The offence alleged to have been committed being one punishable under Section 304A of the IPC, learned counsel for the petitioner would address argument as to how, in the face of the judgment of a Division Bench of this Court in **Baldev Singh v. State of Punjab, 2016 (3) Law Herald 2020**, the FIR can be quashed.

Adjourned to 12.09.2019.”
