Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in a case FIR No.164 dated 26.05.2019, registered at Police Station City Rewari, District Rewari, under Sections 467, 468, 471, 420, 201 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 66, 66-B and 66-D of the Information Technology (Amendment) Act, 2008.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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As per the allegations in the FIR, some accused, including the present petitioner, helped the other co-accused to get passed the examination conducted for the post of Naib Tehsildar, by solving the answer-keys with the help of mobile phone and then sending it to Rewari and other stations.

The petitioner has been in custody since 26.05.2019. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
