Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to official respondents for taking appropriate legal action against the private respondents and to investigate properly in FIR No. 400 dated 16.05.2019, registered under Sections 323, 506 and 34 of the IPC at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh.

Reply, by way of affidavit of SI/SHO, Police Station Nuh, on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 and 2, is filed in Court today. As per reply, the investigation was carried out and the statements of the witnesses were recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C. It is further stated that accused Krishan-respondent No. 4 was arrested on 20.08.2019 and his disclosure statement was recorded and upon verification of the evidence and facts, it is found that there was a dispute between the petitioner and said Krishan Kumar on 12.05.2019 over casting of vote on a polling booth, where the petitioner was deployed as polling agent of a political party and an altercation took place between them. Thereafter, the aforesaid FIR was got registered by the petitioner with the allegations that Krishan Kumar inflicted injuries to him. It

is further stated in reply that during the course of investigation, it was found that Udaybir-respondent No. 5 and Dinesh were not present at the spot and, therefore, on completion of investigation, report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. was prepared against Krishan Kumar and the same was produced before the Illaqua Magistrate on the same day and the case is now fixed for 02.12.2019 for prosecution evidence.

In view of the above, no further action is called for in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach Illaqua Magistrate for redressal of his grievances, if any.
