This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents-Authority to consider and decide the legal notice dated 27.06.2018 (Annexure P-8) expeditiously.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to the respondents-Authority to consider and decide the legal notice dated 27.06.2018 (Annexure P-8) expeditiously, keeping in view the judgments passed by this Hon'ble Court (Annexures P-3 to P-7).

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents -

Authority to consider and decide the legal notice dated 27.06.2018

(Annexure P-8), keeping in view the judgments passed by this Hon'ble Court (Annexures P-3 to P-7), in accordance with law within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the request made by the petitioner is admissible, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to her, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the request made by the petitioner is not admissible, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
