The petitioner has participated for the post of PGT Economics. The final result has been declared on 08.11.2018. The petitioner was considered against the general category. The result of the petitioner has been produced in Court today and he has secured 82 marks in the written examination, 8 marks in experience and 10 marks in the viva-voce. The total marks are 100. The selected candidate under the general category has secured 116 marks. The result has been returned to learned counsel for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that at the time of making application form, the petitioner had EBPG certificate. The last selected candidate under the EBPG category has secured 97 marks.

It has been further stated that the petitioner is already working as Clerk under the EBPG category in District Attorney office, Nuh and it can be assumed that his salary would be more than Rs.6,000/- p.m. Hence, the petitioner had rightly applied against the general category.

Writ petition is dismissed keeping in view less marks of the

petitioner than the last selected candidate under the general category.
