What is under challenge here is the appointment to post of Dean vide office order dated 29.03.2011 (Annexure P-13), whereby the petitioner's claim for the said appointment was negated and respondent No.3 was appointed.

2. During the pendency of the writ petition, not only respondent No.3 has completed his term as Dean but even subsequent thereto, another Dean was appointed, who too successfully completed his term. In the meanwhile, the petitioner has also moved on for greener pastures and taken up employment as Professor in Chaudary Ranbir Singh University, Jind.

3. In my opinion, the petition is rendered infructuous. Even though the petitioner appearing in person submits that he continues to maintain his lien with BPS Mahila Vishwavidyalaya and the relief with respect to his claim of being senior to respondent No.3 has not been addressed. Neither any seniority list is appended nor impugned as per the prayer clause herein. Learned counsel for respondent No.3 has drawn my attention to additional affidavit dated 23.02.2018 of Dr. Ritu Bajaj, Registrar, BPS Mahila,

Vishwavidyalaya (respondent No.1), which clearly indicates that there is no final seniority list drawn by the respondent(s).

4. In the premise, the writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the seniority list.
