The petitioners are relegated to their remedy before the Civil Court,
in case they are advised to claim damages for breach of contract.

However, the period spent in this litigation will be exempted from
limitation under Section 14 of the Limitation Act, 1963. The writ petition was
filed on 20.02.2016 against the cause of action arising out of impugned order
dated 07.12.2015. On the date when the petition was filed, a suit would have been
within the limitation and, therefore, I am persuaded to make this order to exclude
the period for filing of a suit provided it is filed within two months from today.

With these observations, the instant petition stands disposed of.
