Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No. 91 dated 29.06.2018 under Sections 307, 323, 34 IPC and under Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Kabarwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib (P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise. (P-2).

On 12.09.2019, while issuing notice of motion the following order was passed by this Court:

“Contends that cancellation report was prepared way-back on 06.02.2019 and a reference in this regard is made to Annexure P-3.

Notice of motion for 19.09.2019.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.V.G.Jauhar, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice. Copy given. He seeks time to take instructions in the matter by next date of hearing.

On 19.09.2019, this Court passed the following order:-

“Mr.Satveer Singh, Advocate appears, files vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No.2 and the same is taken on record.

ASI Suresh Kumar is present in the Court and has apprised the Court that cancellation report is already prepared and likely to be submitted before the Court of competent jurisdiction, very shortly.

Let needful be done within a period of 2 weeks from today.

Adjourned to 30.10.2019.

To be shown in the urgent list.”

Today, learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jagdeep has apprised the Court that after investigation in the matter, cancellation report has already been submitted before the Court of competent jurisdiction and the same is pending for consideration.

In view of the above, no case is made out to quash the FIR in question and as such the petition is disposed off at this stage.

However, it would be open to the petitioners to raise all the pleas before the learned Illaqa Magistrate where the cancellation report is pending for consideration.
