Instant writ petition has been filed seeking a mandamus for protection of the life and liberty of the petitioners by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5.

It has been averred in the writ petition that both the petitioners have attained the age of majority and they have entered into matrimony against the wishes of elders and under such circumstances they fear for their life and liberty.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Major Singh, apprises the Court that the statement of respondents No.4 and 5 who happen to be the parents of petitioner No.1 have since been recorded and as per which they are not opposed the marriage between the petitioners.

Such circumstances would also perhaps explain the non-appearance of counsel representing the petitioners.

No directions are required to be passed in the instant protection
petition.
