This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of certiorari quashing of the order dated 30.03.2017 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No.4 vide which the representation moved by the petitioner has been dismissed without passing any speaking order and further to direct the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for promotion to the rank of Senior Assistant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner stands promoted to the post of Senior Assistant from the date his juniors were promoted, however, he further states that the consequential relief has not been released.

In view of the fact that the substantial relief has been allowed to the petitioner, the present petition has been rendered infructuous. However,

if the grouse of the petitioner still subsists, the petitioner would be at liberty to make a representation to respondent No.2 - Director, Technical Education and Industrial Training Department, Chandigarh for redressal of his remaining grievances within eight weeks from today and on receipt of the certified copy of the judgment, respondent No.2-Director, Technical Education and Industrial Training Department, Chandigarh will decide the representation expeditiously as per law. However, in case the competent authority feels that the request made by the petitioner is not admissible, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
