By this order, both the aforementioned petitions bearing CRM-M-33148-2019 and CRM-M-42345-2019, shall stand disposed of.

Petitioners in both the petitions pray for grant of anticipatory

bail in FIR No.0072 dated 22.05.2019 registered under Sections 420/506/120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Kotwali, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Chamkaur Singh, has submitted that there are number of cases against petitioner No.1 and her husband. In fact, Crown Credit Cooperative Society Limited has collected huge investments from innocent villagers by promising higher returns and now they are refusing to pay the amount. He further informed the Court that there are almost 100 FIRs against Crown Credit Cooperative Society Limited, in the State of Punjab.

In view thereof, there is no ground to grant concession of pre-arrest bail.

Accordingly, both the petitions are dismissed.
