In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is for the grant of promotional increment for which he is entitled for after completing 23 years of service in view of the Finance Circular No. 17/1990 dated 23.04.1990.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was entitled for this benefit w.e.f. 30.06.2003. He further argues that a bunch of writ petitions involving the same question of law and similar relief/similar prayer has already been disposed of by a Coordinate Bench of this Court on 29.11.2018. He prays that the present writ petition be also disposed of in the same terms.

Learned counsel for the respondent very fairly states that the

question of law as raised in the present writ petition was also the subject matter of consideration before this Court in CWP No. 1013 of 2017, titled as ***Balvir Singh Vs. PSPCL and another***, which has been disposed of by the Coordinate Bench of this Court on 29.11.2018 and, therefore, respondent has no objection in case the present writ petition is also disposed of in terms of CWP No. 1013 of 2017, titled as ***Balvir Singh Vs. PSPCL and another***, decided on 29.11.2018.

Keeping in view the prayer made by counsel for the parties, the present writ petition is disposed of in terms of the order passed by this Court in CWP No.1013 of 2017, decided on 29.11.2018.
