Present petition has been filed for seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.84 dated 13.03.2018 for the offences punishable under Section 22 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

The case of the petitioner is that the petitioner was released on interim bail by the Trial Court to await the Chemical Report from the FSL qua the recovered material. However, after receipt of the Chemical Report, from the FSL, bail of the petitioner was cancelled. As a result, petitioner apprehends his arrest.

A perusal of the file shows that the petitioner was never released on regular bail. He was granted only the interim bail. Although the interim bail granted to the petitioner now stands cancelled, however, he has not surrendered before the Court so far.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to interfere at this stage. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail his remedy by applying for regular bail before the Trial Court; after surrendering before that Court. Trial Court is further requested that; in case the petitioner applies for regular bail, then his application may be decided on the same day when it is moved.
