The prayer in this petition is for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.86 dated 01.06.2018, registered under Sections 302, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Fazilka.

As per the case of the prosecution contained in the FIR, the petitioner had exhorted by saying that the deceased has to be taught a lesson for teasing the girl. Apart from the above, the petitioner has not caused any injury to the deceased. The petitioner is in custody since 18.06.2018, i.e., 01 year, 01 month and 27 days. Investigation is complete, challan has been presented and charges have been framed. The prosecution intends to examine 23 witnesses, however, none has been examined so far. The conclusion of the trial is likely to take time.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is granted the concession of bail pending trial. He be released on bail pending

trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Trail Court/Duty Magistrate.
