The prayer made in this petition is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to execute the order passed under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 [for short 'the Act'] which has attained finality.

On the last date of hearing, counsel for the respondents had submitted that pursuant to the order of eviction, execution application has been filed in the Court of Assistant Collector, Ist Grade, Jhajjar and, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.

Faced with this argument, counsel for the petitioner prays for disposal of the petition with a direction to the executing Court to decide the execution application within a time prescribed by this Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Executing Court, who is seized of the execution application for eviction of the unauthorized occupant from the shamlat land, to decide the execution application within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
