Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner—Raj Kumar in case F.I.R. No.95 dated 08.03.2019 under Sections 120-B, 34, 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Mahendergarh, District Mahendergarh.

Power of Attorney filed on behalf of the complainant is taken on record.

Allegations against the petitioner and his brother Rajbir are that they in connivance with each other had received a sum of Rs.6.5 Lakh from complainant Dharmender, Rs.1.5 Lakh from complainant Indrawati and Rs.4.2 Lakh from complainant Laxmi Narain for providing job in Ordinance Factory and Haryana Police.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and appraisal of the record, this Court is of the considered view that the matter requires intensive investigation and no ground is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the present petition is dismissed.
