On 21.08.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.904 dated 23.11.2016 registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 201 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Sector-55, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that initially the final report was filed against 3 accused on the basis whereof in the regular trial, all the 3 accused were acquitted vide judgment dated 18.02.2019 as the prosecution miserably failed to bring home the guilt of the accused. After acquittal, the prosecution has now started harassing the petitioner-wife of Narender Rawat-accused (acquitted vide judgment dated 18.02.2019).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Haryana. A copy of the paper book be handed over to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Adjourned to 15.10.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal

bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and not required for custodial interrogation at this stage.

In view of the above, the order dated 21.08.2019 is made absolute.
