HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 92, dated 25.10.2018, registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and under Section 13 of Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012, at P.S. Mehta, District Amritsar.

The allegations in the FIR are that petitioner and his brother Baljit Singh had taken an amount of Rs. 65000/- each from complainants Gagandeep Singh, Akashdeep Singh, Pawandeep Singh and Mehakpreet for sending them to Dubai on work permit. However, only two first persons were sent to Dubai on tourist visa instead of work permit. There, they had to spend another Rs. 50000/- each to extend their visa and also to pay Rs. 45000/- each to the company to get a job.

Vide order dated 4.10.2019, this Court, while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail, directed the petitioner to join the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baldev Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of above, petition is allowed. The order dated 4.10.2019, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is

made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
