Learned State counsel submits that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous in view of order dated 17.08.2017 (Annexure R1), whereby, the anomaly with respect to the seniority list has been corrected.

Even otherwise, learned State counsel points out that no one has been appearing for the petitioner in the present case as is reflected from order dated 21.12.2017, when the case was adjourned for 05.04.2018. Even on 05.04.2018, none had appeared for the petitioner and the matter was adjourned for 10.09.2018. On 10.09.2018, when the turn did not come, it was adjourned for today.
