The present revision petition has been filed against the order dated 08.07.2019 passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Faridabad (for short, the trial Court), vide which, the ex-parte order dated 18.12.2018 was set aside and defendant Nos.2 to 6 were allowed to join the proceedings.

The order dated 18.12.2018 reads as under:-

“Notice issued to defendants No.1 to 7 received back duly served but they did not appear. It is already 3.30 p.m. Waited sufficiently. No more wait is justified. Hence, defendant Nos.1 to 7 are proceeded against ex-parte. Now, the case is adjourned to 20.12.2018 for consideration.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners while praying for setting aside the order submitted that the application was filed only on behalf of defendant No.2 and not by others.

Heard.

A perusal of the application shows that the same was filed by the concerned counsel on behalf of defendant Nos.2 to 6, meaning thereby, all the defendants want to join the proceedings. Ex-parte order was passed

In these circumstance, this Court finds no reason to set aside the order passed by the trial Court.

Dismissed accordingly.

However, the costs imposed upon defendants No.2 to 6 by the trial Court is now enhanced to ₹1,000/- each to be paid by each of the defendants to the plaintiff.
