G.S. SANDHAWALIA, J. (Oral) :

Learned counsel prays for withdrawal of the present petition wherein prayer is made for releasing the payment admissible to the petitioner for compensation of her husband's land.

On 4.12.2018 the following order was passed by this Court :-

“Counsel prays for time to file affidavit giving details as per the averments made in para No.10 of the writ petition. The affidavit will be supported by necessary zimni orders, in case the application (Annexure P-2) was entertained by the Court and as to what is the status of the said application, as an argument is sought to be raised that the application was not entertained by the Executing Court.

List on 18.12.2018.

It is made clear that in case it is found that the application has been duly considered, in its proper perspective, the petitioner shall pay exemplary costs for unfounded aspirations on the Executing Court.”

The said order has not been complied with.

Resultantly, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action after necessary compliance of the aforesaid order.
