The present writ petition has been filed for setting aside the order dated 13.10.2017 (Annexure P-10) by which claim of the petitioner for computing the daily wage/work charge service rendered by him as a qualifying service for the grant of pensionary benefits was declined.

Today, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana on instructions from Vinod Kumar Goyal, XEN 'OP' SU-I, UHBVNL, Karnal, who is present in Court, states that on re-consideration, the respondents have decided to grant the benefits of the daily wage/work charge service to the petitioner for computing the same as a qualifying service for the grant of the pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that an appropriate order granting the petitioner the benefit as prayed in this writ petition will

be passed within a period of one month from today and the consequential benefits arising out of the said order will also be released to the petitioner within a period of one month thereafter.

Keeping in view the undertaking given by the learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana on instructions from Vinod Kumar Goyal, XEN 'OP' SU-I, UHBVNL, Karnal, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not wish to press the writ petition any further.

Writ petition stands disposed of as not pressed.
