The petitioner has filed present criminal revision against the judgment dated 01.06.2019 passed by learned Principal District Judge (Family Court), Hisar whereby the petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. for grant of maintenance filed by the respondent-wife, was allowed and a sum of Rs.11,000/- per month was granted to the respondent as maintenance from the date of filing of the petition along with a sum of Rs.11,000/- as litigation expenses.

This Court, vide order dated August 27, 2019 had directed the parties to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 26.09.2019. Pursuant thereto, the parties had appeared before the Mediator and it has been reported by the Mediator that the matter has been settled between the parties vide settlement/agreement dated 16.10.2019.

Considering the fact that the matter has been settled between the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that the parties shall adhere to the settlement/agreement dated 16.10.2019 so arrived at between them before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

The settlement/agreement dated 16.10.2019 be made part of the record.
