ARUN MONGA, J.(ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that objection that the Bathinda Central Cooperative Bank Limited is not amenable to writ jurisdiction of this Court, is totally misplaced. In the event of non-compliance of the directions of the Registrar Cooperative Societies, the petitioners can invoke the writ jurisdiction qua a Society registered under the Punjab Cooperative Societies Act, 1961, he contends further.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are serving as Peon/Sweeper/Watchman and Class-IV posts and living in penurious condition.

3. He further submits that despite respondent No.2- The

Registrar Cooperative Societies, Punjab having passed the order dated 20.03.2013 (Annexure P-3), wherein Assured Career Progression was approved to be implemented by respondent No.3-The Bathinda Central Cooperative Bank Limited, the same has not been carried out to its logical conclusion.

4. In the premise, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- The Registrar Cooperative Societies, Punjab to take appropriate action in respect of its order/letter dated 20.03.2013 (Annexure P-3) to ensure that compliance thereof is made, as per the recommendations contained therein.

5. Let the needful be done within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

6. Petition stands disposed of.
