The petitioner already having been released on bail, vide an order passed on 29.10.2019, the matter had been kept pending only with regard to the issue of the CCTV footage as was sought to be obtained by learned counsel for the complainant (as recorded in the order dated 18.09.2019).

The CCTV footage has also been perused by the Court, which shows activities outside court room numbers 53 and 55, and to an extent outside this Court (Court room no. 54), though not very clearly because no camera is stated to have been installed directly outside this Court room.

Be that as it may, since the CCTV footage has been placed on record and has also been perused by this Court, without making any comment on the contents thereof, this petition is disposed of, with the complainant at liberty to avail of his remedies either in terms of anything that he wishes to point out from the said footage, or otherwise, with the concerned person in the Registry of this

Court directed to inform counsel for the complainant as regards the password to access the footage.

Of course, if the password is common to other data in the Registry or any particular cameras which are not required to be divulged to any person other than the concerned persons in the Registry of this Court, the said password would be changed by the concerned person and a new password inserted for the purpose of the CCTV footage taken on record in this petition, and that new password would only be divulged to the complainant/his counsel.
