AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 03.05.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No.19636 of 2013.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced below:-

“4. In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to make payment of Rs.33,415/- in addition to the payment of Rs.1,38,751/- already made and in case the payment is not made within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, the same would carry interest @ 9% per annum from the date of accrual till date of payment. The petitioner would also be at liberty to approach respondent No.5 to inspect the record and on his being able to show to respondent No.5 from the record that he has worked from 10.02.2011 till 20.02.2014 or any other date beyond the said

date, in such eventuality, wages would be paid to the petitioner accordingly. In case the petitioner is still aggrieved he would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law before the appropriate forum.”

Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that due payment has already been made. Apart from ₹33,415/-, another amount of ₹50,521/- was paid.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though due amount has been paid but the interest @ 9% has not been paid as payment was made after four weeks from receipt of certified copy.

Learned counsel for respondent submits that certified copy was not supplied to the respondent, hence, no interest is to be awarded.

The contempt petition is disposed of as substantial compliance of directions of this Court. However, reasoned order with regard to claim of interest would be passed by the respondent within six weeks from today after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

Let petitioner appear before the respondent in his office on 24.09.2019 at 11:00 A.M.
