Application is allowed and the additional affidavit of the petitioner filed along with the application is taken on record.

CWP-21746-2019

On advance service of copy of the petition, learned counsel for respondent No.4 submits that vide order dated 12.7.2019 (Annexure P-4), impugned herein, even though the petitioner has been transferred from Ferozepur Range (Ferozepur Division) to Extension Range, Ferozepur (Extension Division, Bathinda), but as per her instructions, the petitioner would ordinarily be placed at Ferozepur Division, i.e., the same place of posting where he was posted and he would be sent to Extension Range, Bathinda as and when he would be required by the Extension Range,

Bathinda.

In any case, the transfer being matter of administrative exigencies, I am not inclined to interfere in the impugned transfer order in exercise of extraordinary writ jurisdiction vested under Article 226 of Constitution of India, particularly in view of the submissions made by learned counsel for respondent No.4, as stated above.
3. Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
