Mr. Deepak Balyan, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent. Copy furnished.

In the nature of the order we propose to pass, no formal written statement/counter affidavit is indeed necessary on behalf of the respondent, at this stage. Thus, with the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the petition is being finally disposed of.

A writ of certiorari is prayed for to quash the communication dated 23.07.2019 vide which the technical bid of the petitioner has since been rejected being non-responsive.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondent-authorities have not assigned any reason as to how and on what basis the petitioner has been technically disqualified. It is urged that even though the price bid was opened by the respondent on the same day i.e. 23.07.2019, but the contract has not yet been finalized or settled in favour of

any party. Further, the petitioner represented to the authorities the same day, post rejection of its technical bid, vide representation dated 23.07.2019 (Annexure P-4), but to no avail.

2. In response, learned State counsel submits that let this petition be disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to the respondent to consider the concerns and grievances of the petitioner and decide its representation by passing appropriate orders.

3. In the wake of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of only with a direction to the respondent that if indeed any such representation, as indicated above, is pending before the authorities, the same shall be considered and decided by passing appropriate orders in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from today. Needless to assert that the authorities shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
