Main Case

Learned counsel appearing for Punjab and Haryana
High Court Bar Association states that Draft Rules prepared by the
Sub Committee after due perusal thereof by the Executive
Committee have been passed by the General House. He contends

that the said Rules have been framed as per the judgment rendered by the Supreme Court of India in case titled as ***Supreme Court Bar Association and Others Vs. B.D.Kaushik reported as 2011 (13) SCC 774.***

Keeping in view the submissions of learned counsel appearing for the Bar Association, the present petition is dismissed as infructuous as the same was filed to seek framing of the Rules in compliance with the judgment of the Supreme Court, *ibid.*

However, it is made clear that petitioner is at liberty to seek appropriate remedy, at a later stage, if he would have any grievance qua the said Rules.
