ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.85 dated 28.06.2019, under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR would not prima facie constitute an offence under Section 306 IPC. The FIR has been registered by the mother of the deceased alleging therein that the petitioner, who was the wife of the deceased, had been visiting foreign countries while pursuing the profession of dancing which was against the wishes of the deceased. He contends that neither there is any suicide note nor any other evidence to connect the petitioner with the commission of the offence. The petitioner is 34 years old lady with two minor children and not involved in any other case. She is in custody for over 2 months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Gurmukh Singh states that the challan has been presented but charges are yet to be framed.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when there is no suicide note, the petitioner is a lady with two minor children, she is in custody for over 2 months and the conclusion of trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
