1. Grievance of the petitioners herein is that their services have not been regularized, whereas juniors to them have been accorded the benefit of regularization. It is stated that the petitioners are entitled to the same benefit as has been given to another co-employee Balwinder Singh though pursuant to a decree and judgment of trial Court(Civil Judge) as upheld by first Appellate Court(ADJ) vide its judgment dated 16.08.2017 (Annexure P-5) passed by Additional District Judge. In the premise, the petitioners submitted a representation dated 24.04.2019(Annexure P-6), but the same has not been adverted to by the respondents. Hence, this writ petition.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Ambika Bedi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondents.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation dated 24.04.2019 (Annexure P-6) and also by keeping in

view the contentions stated in this petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. Disposed of in above terms.
