Petitioner Aman @ Aju has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.98 dated 23.06.2019, registered at Police Station Division No.1, District Ludhiana, under Section 379-B(2) IPC, 1860.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

The FIR in the present case has been got registered by Mukesh Kumar, who stated that when he was coming back along with his relative Bhim Kumar, then two unknown boys stopped them and after showing knife, snatched his mobile phone, which cost about ₹10,000/- to whom he can recognize. The record shows that the present petitioner is nominated on the basis of extra judicial confession made by him.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; in view of the nature and gravity of the offence and the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail and the mobile phone is still to be recovered.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
