In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the counsel for the petitioner is that though the services of the petitioner have been regularised by the respondents w.e.f. 11.09.1988 but the benefit of said regularisation has not been extended to the petitioner for the grant of ACP and other benefits.

Counsel for the petitioner further argues that even the qualifying service of the petitioner has been counted from 01.01.1991 and not from 11.09.1988, which is totally arbitrary and illegal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 14.03.2018 (Annexure P-10) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case

a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the

legal notice dated 14.03.2018 (Annexure P-10) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 14.03.2018 (Annexure P-10), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 14.03.2018 (Annexure P-10) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the representations, the same should also be paid to him within three months thereafter.
