By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

Learned counsel submits that the petitioner was arrested on 'secret information' alleged to have been received, with him also having pointed to a resolution stated to have been passed by the Gram Panchayat, that the petitioner was actually picked up from home.

Without making any comment on the validity of even the document that he has pointed to, with it also not known whether such defence would be taken before the trial court at the appropriate time, simply looking at the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for 2 years and 4 months, with the trial not anywhere near conclusion as yet, I consider it appropriate to allow this petition.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, this petition is allowed. The petitioner would be enlarged on bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail and

surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
