Petitioner prays for regular bail in FIR No.72 dated 09.06.2019 under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

As per the case of the prosecution, recovery from the possession of the petitioner is (A) 30 glass injection vials, each labelled as 'AVIL' and containing 10 ml of colourless liquid material (B) 20 glass injection ampoules, each ampoule labelled as 'LEEFESIC' and containing 2 ml of colourless liquid material and (C) 10 glass injection ampoules, each ampoule labelled as 'BUPINE' and containing 2 ml of colourless liquid material.

It is not in dispute that 'AVIL' is not covered under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 .

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated and even if the total recovery from the petitioner is taken into consideration i.e 30 ampoules of 2 ml each, the total quantity would be 60 ml. He further contends that if the neutral substances are

Investigations are complete. Prosecution has recorded evidence of one witness out of total thirteen witnesses proposed to be examined. He is not involved in any other case as per the custody certificate.

Keeping in view the facts of the case and without commenting on merits, this petition is allowed and petitioner-Jasvir Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.

The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on merits of case.
