In connected case i.e. CWP No.9725 of 2018, learned State counsel has filed two affidavits, one of Manoj Yadav, Director General of Police, Haryana and other of Dhanpat Singh, Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Transport Department. He submits that he has received instructions from Dr. Rajshree Singh, I.G.P. Traffic and Highways (H), Karnal, who has charge of traffic control all over the State. According to him, the police department is ready to conduct a joint special campaign with the Transport Department to curb illegal plying of three-wheelers. Para 8 of the affidavit filed by Additional Chief Secretary to Transport Department in the connected case reads as under:-

“8. That to stop illegal plying of three-wheelers (auto-rickshaws) and to comply with the orders of this Hon'ble Court, the respondent department has issued directions to all the ADCs-cum-Secretaries, Regional Transport Authorities in the State vide letter No.9069-9091/AT-9/ST-II, dated 20.03.2019 to ensure that if any three-wheeler/auto-rickshaw operator violates the terms and conditions of permit or ply their vehicles in violation of the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and rules framed thereunder, the same should be challaned under Section 192-A of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.”

As the learned State counsel, on instructions from Dr. Rajshree Singh, I.G.P., has ensured the court that all possible steps shall be taken in view of the aforesaid affidavits, no further direction is necessary. Petition is hereby disposed of. A status report may, however, be filed in the Registry within four months.
