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TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners have sought a mandamus for directing respondent No.3 to protect their personal life and liberty and by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of respondent No.4. Further directions are sought that the petitioners be not unnecessarily harassed only on the pretext that two other sons and petitioner No.1 who had a separate residence have been implicated in an NDPS matter.

Counsel for the petitioners has been heard and the case paper book has been perused.

Pleadings on record are grossly insufficient to infer any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners. Even the averments with regard to harassment allegedly meted out to them are utterly vague.

No intervention in the matter is called for.

Dismissed.
