Counsel for the petitioner states that the relief as prayed in the writ petition has already been granted to the petitioner.

The petitioner was seeking the release of the family pension in the present writ petition, which has already been released by the respondents. Pension Certificate has been produced by the counsel for the respondents in Court today. Copy has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner so as to support that the benefits for which the present writ petition was filed, has already been extended to her.

Counsel for the petitioner does not oppose the certificate

produced before this Court that the amount has already been deposited in the account of the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner be given liberty to approach the respondents for grant of interest, if any, by filing an appropriate representation.

Liberty for the same is granted. In case any representation is filed by the petitioner within a period of four weeks claiming interest, the respondents shall dispose of the same by passing an appropriate speaking order within next two months keeping in view the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in **A.S. Randhawa Vs. State of Punjab 1997(3) SCT 468.**

The present writ petition stands disposed of.
