This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.112 dated 3.4.2019, registered at Police Station Chandhut, District Palwal.

As per the case of the prosecution, on 31.3.2019 at about 8.30 a.m. when complainant Lokesh alongwith his brother Narender was returning home from the fields, the petitioner alongwith his co-accused, who were armed with weapons, waylaid them and exhorted to teach a lesson for making complaints against them to the police. The assailants caused injuries to the complainant and his brother Narender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that originally the FIR was registered for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 34 IPC and subsequently, offences punishable under Sections 325 and 326 IPC were added.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the

investigation of the case is complete and the final report stands filed on 1.7.2019. He submits that considering 6 months period of custody, further detention of the petitioner may not be justified.

Learned State counsel assisted by HC Shri Chand, P.S. Chandhul, District Palwal has not disputed this fact that challan stands filed, however, according to him, the eye witnesses are yet to be examined.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, this Court does not find any reason to further detain the petitioner in custody, as the trial is likely to consume considerable time. Therefore, without meaning any expression of opinion on the merits of the case, petitioner Mahavir is admitted to regular bail subject to his furnishing the requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition is allowed.
