The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 50 dated 18.07.2019, under Sections 452, 323, 427, 380, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Section 325 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Shahpur Kandi, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the incident is the outcome of an altercation in which petitioner No.1 had also received injuries, which are reflected in the copy of the MLR appended as Annexure P2. He also contends that petitioners are sisters and petitioner No. 1 is 20 years of age while petitioner No. 2 is 26 years old.

This Court by the order dated 21.08.2019 had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrests, they were ordered to be

released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Tarsem Kumar, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 21.08.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
