The present petition has been filed with following substantive prayers:-

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the present petition may kindly be accepted, and the respondents no.2 to 4 may kindly be directed to do free fair and proper investigation of the case FIR No.0022 dated 25.04.2017 under Sections 430, 149, 504, 506, of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 70(4) of the Eastern Canal Act, registered at Police Station PS Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka.

It is further prayed for issuance of directions to the respondents no.2 and 4 to complete the investigation in case FIR No.0022 dated 25.04.2017 under Sections 430, 149, 504, 506, of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 70(4) of the Eastern Canal Act, registered at Police Station PS

Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka, and to produce the challan before the Ld. Trial Court.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhpal Singh, has submitted that Superintendent of Police, Abohar has concluded the enquiry and found that FIR has been correctly registered which has been approved by the Senior Superintendent of Police. He gives an assurance on behalf of police that further steps shall be taken in accordance with law.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of with a hope that police would discharge its functions in accordance with law.
