TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners seek a mandamus for directing the official respondents to take necessary steps for protection of their life and liberty and by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.5 to 15.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Hardeep Singh apprises the Court that statement of respondent No.5/Chand Singh, who is father of petitioner No.4 has been recorded and as per such statement, the apprehension voiced by the petitioners as regards threat to their life and liberty is not correct and well founded.

Be that as it may, the instant writ petition is disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No.4 i.e. the S.H.O., Police Station Dayalpura, Bathinda as regards their threat perception.

In the eventuality of the petitioners approaching respondent

No.4, he would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
