AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

At the outset, Mr.Sewak, learned Addl.AG, Punjab, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh, has informed this Court that petitioner no.1, i.e. Jathedar Baba Prem Singh, has died.

Obviously, the petition has been rendered infructuous qua him and is disposed of as such.

As regards petitioner no.2 (Baba Dayal Singh), learned State counsel has submitted that he has joined investigation and that his custodial interrogation is not required presently.

That being so, in fact the petition has been rendered infructuous even qua respondent no.2 also and is disposed of.

However, since learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in such a situation petitioner no.2 would be left at the “mercy of the investigating officer”, the order dated 30.8.2019 is made absolute,

subject obviously to any application being filed by the State seeking that the bail granted to him be cancelled.

Naturally, the right of the complainant in respect of any grievance that he may have, stands protected.
