1. The petitioner herein, inter alia, seeks writ of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the claim of the petitioner for regularization of his services. The petitioners also caused issuance of a legal notice dated 31.07.2019 (Annexure P-8) but the same has not been adverted to till date by the respondents.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Senior Advocate assisted by Ms. Ambika Bedi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondents.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to objectively consider the legal notice dated 31.07.2019 (Annexure P-8) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in this petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with

law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
